I am currently reading Oswald Chamber's book "Studies in the Sermon on the Mount."

It is a wonderful look at this amazing sermon of our Lord Jesus.

Chambers wants us to learn that this is not simply an instruction from great teacher,  
but rather the way our Lord and Savior seeks to remake us.

*Chambers writes: "Beware of placing our Lord as Teacher first instead of Savior. ...  
If we know Him first as Savior, we know that He did not come to teach us only:  
He came to make us what He teaches we should be. The Sermon on the Mount  
is a statement of the life we will live when the Holy Spirit is having His way with us."*

So, this summer let's spend twelve weeks exploring Jesus' Sermon on the Mount,  
especially as it teaches us about God's character and our conduct.

Let's discover just what it means when the Holy Spirit has His way with us!

**What will that look like??**

Over the 12 weeks from June 9 through August 31 we'll read short passages from the Sermon on the Mount!

The devos will still include Sunday gospel readings on Saturdays.

We'll distribute these Devotions in two sets - 7 weeks of passages on June 9 & 5 weeks of passages on July 28.

They are for adults, youth, children and families alike. They will also be available on the website.
